<u>Ascension Thursday</u> – today we have been to mass to celebrate this feast day, which is a Holy Day of Obligation, having been moved back again from Sunday to Thursday. <u>First Holy Communion</u> – Year 3 will make their First Holy Communion on **Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> May 10:30am**. All children need to be in church by 10:15am. Please be aware that parking will be difficult so give yourselves plenty of time! Please would the school choir arrive at school for 9:00 for a final rehearsal. They will need to wear their school uniform (blue shirts and ties).

There will be a whole school Thanks Giving Mass on **Tuesday 22<sup>rd</sup> May** in Church at 9:20am, followed by a Communion Party in the school hall for Year 3 and their parents, grandparents and prayers sponsors. All parents and grandparents are welcome to come along and join this lovely mass.

<u>Birds of Prey</u> – the children will have opportunity to see a variety of birds and learn about their habitats etc. School have been able to subsidise this workshop but need to ask a voluntary donation of £1.00 per child from Yr R to Yr 6.

<u>Picnic lunch</u> – on Friday May 18<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting, we will be having a picnic lunch to celebrate the Royal Wedding. Parents do not need to send anything extra to school as children who have a school dinner will be provided with a packed lunch.

<u>Dinner Money/Nursery snack fund</u> — please would you bring any outstanding payments up-to-date; reminders have been sent out this week Please ensure that the correct money is placed in an envelope clearly marked with the pupils' name and class and handed to their class teacher, as we do not hold large amounts of change. At present unfortunately, you are unable to pay via Tameside website. We will advise you when this becomes available again. We apologies for any inconvenience this may cause.

We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

From September 2018 any pupils moving up to year 3 will not be entitled to the Universal free school meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. Please see above with ways regarding making payment. If you wish your child to change to a packed lunch please would you let the office know by the 13<sup>th</sup> July.

<u>Year 6 dinner money</u> - please check with school office before making any payments in advance as any overpayments at the end of the academic year cannot be refunded.
