• 94% achieved the expected standard in reading and 97% in grammar & maths. National score for reading, writing and maths combined is 65%, schools combined score is 94%

Year 6 dinner money - please check with the school office before making any final payments for week commencing 22nd July as any overpayments at the end of the academic year cannot be refunded.

From September 2019 any pupils moving up to year 3 <u>will not</u> be entitled to the Universal free school meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. Please see above with ways regarding making payment. If you wish your child to change to a packed lunch, please would you let the office know by the Friday 12th July.

If you are already eligible for free school meals due to income this will be in place for September. If your circumstances change you may be eligible to apply for free school meals. More information is available at <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u> >council tax and benefits>free school meals.

Please note there is a slight school meal increase to £2.30 per day from the 1st September

<u>Nursery Snack Fund</u> – please bring your snack fund up-to-date, reminder texts have been sent to parents. If you are unsure of the outstanding amounts, please speak to the school office staff.

Packed lunches – due to an incident at school no food warmers will be allowed from Monday 15th July. We thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

<u>School uniform orders</u> – JFC orders to be processed through school no later than Thursday 18th July to allow for orders to be back in time to distribute, orders after this date can be purchased direct from school's official uniform suppliers - JFC Sports, Unit 8 Redfern Ind. Estate, off Market Street, Hyde and MCS uniform shop, 32 Market Street, Ashton-under-lyne. School uniforms lists were given out previously, alternatively further copies can be downloaded from the website or pick up a copy from the school office. Please note hairstyles must still comply with our policy right up the last day of term.
