Inset day – the third and final INSET day of the year has now been arranged. School will be closed on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2020 for staff training.

<u>Mass</u> - We will be celebrating a whole school Mass for the end of term on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December at 9:15am. Everybody is welcome. Mass will take place in the school hall due to ongoing building works in church. Please bear with us with seating arrangements as we try to fit everyone in.

<u>Admission to school September 2020</u>– letters have been posted. If your child is registered at our school and you haven't received a copy of the application process, then contact the school office. Closing date for online applications is **15<sup>th</sup> January 2020.** Please note that school requires a copy of birth and baptism certificates, along with two proofs of residency. More detailed information is available on the school website under the Admissions section.

<u>Nursery hours funded</u> – If your child's hours of funding are to increase or decrease from January then please contact the school office or send an email to <u>admin@st-peters.tameside.sch.uk</u> to advise the change in hours.

<u>Nursery electronic gate</u> - for safety reasons the electronic gate will be opened at 8:55 am and 11:55am by school staff. When leaving the premises, the green exit button is to be operated by an adult only. Please ensure your child does not press the button for safety reasons.

<u>Dinner Monies / Nursery Snack Fund</u> –please would you bring any outstanding payments up-to-date. Alternatively, you can pay for school meals on-line using the link at <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u> and click on the link school meals. *We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.*
