<u>Whole school Mass</u> – we will be celebrating a whole school Mass for the end of term on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> December at 9:15am. Everybody welcome. We will also be having Mass to celebrate the **Epiphany** on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> January at 9:15am. Please note we will only be attending Mass and not participating in it.

<u>Junior Christmas Productions</u> - Junior children to arrive back at school for the evening performances at 5:15pm. The performance will start at 5:45pm. Admission will be by ticket only. If anyone forgets tickets, then we will ask them to wait until everybody else is in the hall and then we can assess capacity. Please do not forget your tickets to avoid any upset.

DVD order forms for both Infant and Junior productions will be available at the shows or alternatively send in payment of  $\pm 6.50$  for each DVD along with your child's name and class clearly marked on the envelope. The junior production DVD to be ordered by 4.00pm Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> December in order that they can be distributed before the Christmas break. Orders for either production received after this time will be available in the New Year.

**School Dinner Money** –school dinner money for next term will be £65.25 (29 days), and alternatively you can pay weekly £11.25. School fund next term will be £6.00 per family for the term payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School. **Nursery snack fund** for the term will be £21.50 payable to St Peter's Catholic Primary School; alternatively you can use the School Money on-line system www.eduspot.co.uk a text will be sent week commencing 7<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

Admission to school September 2019 – If your child is registered at our school and you haven't received a copy of the application process, then contact the school office for more information. Closing date for online applications is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019. Please note that school requires a copy of birth and baptism certificates, along with two proofs of residency. More detailed information is available on the school website under the Admissions section. The Admissions' policy for 2020 – 2021 is now on our website for consultation. Please note there are changes in the over-subscription criteria as all Shrewsbury schools must now follow the Diocesan model policy.
