<u>Current Year 2 pupils</u> - From September 2017 any pupils moving up to year 3 <u>will not be entitled</u> to the Universal free school meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. If you wish your child to change to a packed lunch please would you let the office know by **Friday 14**th July.

Please note there is a slight school meal increase to £2.18 per day from the 1st September

<u>Nursery Snack Fund</u> – please bring your snack fund up-to-date, reminder texts have been sent to parents. If you are unsure of the outstanding amounts, please speak to the school office staff.

<u>All Saints 3rd monitoring visit by OFSTED</u> – Mrs Emmett has asked me to let parents know that the 3rd monitoring visit has been extremely positive. The report will be made available as soon as it is released from OFSTED. The team of very experienced Governors, Directors and Senior Leadership are determined to move All Saints to an OFSTED judgement of 'Good' in the very near future and eventually to move to 'Outstanding'.
