**Dear Parents** 

<u>Whole school Mass</u> – we will be celebrating a whole school Mass for the end of term on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> December at 9:15am. Everybody welcome. We will also be having Mass to celebrate the **Epiphany** on **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2017.** 

<u>Infant and Junior Productions</u> - thank you for your kind donations at the door. Total money collected £543.00. Cheques will be sent off today in support of Willow Wood Hospice and Francis House Hospice for children.

<u>School Dinner Money</u> –school dinner money for next term will be £72.42 (34 days), and alternatively you can pay weekly £10.65. School fund next term will be £7.00 per family for the term payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School. Nursery snack fund for the term will be £24.50 payable to St Peter's Catholic Primary School; alternatively you can use the School Money on-line system <a href="www.schoolmoney.co.uk">www.schoolmoney.co.uk</a> a text will be sent week commencing 2nd January 2017.

<u>Residential trips</u> – please would you bring your payments up-to-date. If you wish to pay by cheque, please make cheques payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School alternatively you can pay using the online payment scheme <u>www.schoolmoney.co.uk</u> The next instalments will be due on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2017 for Boreatton and 23<sup>rd</sup> January for Robinwood.

Admission to school September 2017 – letters have now been sent out. If your child is registered at our school and you haven't received a copy of the application process then contact the school office. Closing date for online applications is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2017. *Please ensure that school has received two copies of your proof of residency by this date.* 

<u>Nursery Admissions September 2017</u> – letters will be posted on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> December to parents who have registered an interest in our nursery school. School requires a copy of birth and baptism certificates, along with two proofs of residency for nursery applications.

<u>Change of contact/Telephone numbers</u> – please would you let the office know as soon as possible if any emergency contact details, telephone numbers or home addresses have changed in order that we can update or records.

<u>Infant Book bags</u> – just a reminder that all children in the Infants should have a book bag and not a ruck sack, as there is not enough room to store them. We would appreciate it if the children could have a book bag as soon as you are able, these can be purchased from our uniform suppliers or ordered through school. Thank you for your continued support.

Swimming Lessons – Year 4 will swim next term. This starts on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> January. The children will need swimming trunks – not sports shorts, a swimsuit – not a bikini, a towel in a plastic bag or swimming bag. If children have been prescribed an inhaler, they must take their inhaler with them. Copley will not allow children to wear goggles unless it is for medical reasons, which needs to be in writing. Parent volunteers are also required. If you are able to help, please see Miss Holland.
