Dear Parents

<u>NSPCC – Year 1 and 2</u> - as part of their Lenten fundraising the children raised £612.60 doing a sponsored buddy work out. Thank you very much for all your support in this worthy cause.

<u>First Holy Communion</u> – Year 3 will make their First Holy Communion on **Saturday 18th May 10:30am**. All children need to be in church by 10:15am. Please be aware that parking will be difficult so give yourselves plenty of time! Please would the school choir arrive at school for 9:00 for a final rehearsal. They will need to wear their school uniform (blue shirts and ties).

There will be a whole school Thanks Giving Mass on **Tuesday 21st May** in Church at 9:20am, followed by a Communion Party in the school hall for Year 3 and their parents, grandparents and prayers sponsors. All parents and grandparents are welcome to come along and join this lovely mass.

<u>Whit Walks 2019</u> - (Sunday 9th June). This year's Whit Walk Service will take place at the usual time of 2.30pm in Armentieres Square, processing from St. Peter's & St. Raphael's Church led by St. John's Brass Band, Mossley. Please aim to arrive at church from 1:30 onwards as the procession will be ready to leave at 2:00pm. On return from the walks there will tea, coffee and refreshments in the parish hall.

Year 6 trips – the last instalment is now overdue. Please bring any outstanding payments up-to-date.

<u>Dinner Money/Nursery snack fund</u> – Please would you bring any outstanding payments up-to-date. Please ensure that money is placed in an envelope clearly marked with the pupil's name and class and handed to their class teacher, alternatively you can pay through the Tameside website <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u> school & education > school meals. We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

From September 2019 any pupils moving up to year 3 will not be entitled to the Universal free school meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. Please see above with ways regarding making payment. If you wish your child to change to a packed lunch, please would you let the office know by the 12th July.

<u>Year 6 dinner money</u> - please check with school office before making any payments in advance as any overpayments at the end of the academic year cannot be refunded.

<u>Year 6 Bikeability</u> – this will take place **Monday 10th June**. To take part in this safer cycling course, children must be able to ride a bike and the bike must be roadworthy. This course will involve cycling on the road, once the instructors have deemed that the children have the necessary skills. Please note the instructors will not be able to teach children how to ride a bike.
