<u>Mass & Assembly</u> –Year 1 class mass is on Tuesday 23rd October at 9:00am in the chapel, Parents and Grandparents welcome. Apologies but Year 6 assembly planned for Friday 19th October will now be re-scheduled for some time in January. Mrs Barber has a family funeral to attend on the 19th October.

<u>Inset day</u> – the third and final INSET day of the year has now been arranged. School will be closed on **Friday 11th January 2019** for staff training. This is the only date that the consultant trainer is available to lead our school improvement focus.

<u>October – The Month of the Holy Rosary</u> - we are inviting parents, grandparents and children to come into the hall and pray a decade of the Holy Rosary every Thursday morning in October at 8:40am. Please come along and take the opportunity to pray and reflect together.

<u>Year 6 – transfer from Primary to Year 7 (High School) – September 2019.</u> The online admission process is now open. Parents will need to log on to Tameside MBC school admissions and register to submit an application and access the 'Moving On' booklet <u>www.tameside.gov.uk/admissions</u> The closing date is Wednesday 31st October 2018. Admissions submitted after this date will be treated as late.

<u>Social Media and On-line safety</u> – please could I implore all parents to regularly check their children's messages and on-line activity. We have been made aware of some disturbing communications between children when at home. Despite many sessions of e-safety teaching, some children are completely unaware of the appropriate way to communicate and also of their vulnerability when communicating with people they don't know, usually through gaming sites. Please refer to our safeguarding website where there are updates about Fortnight and Tik Tok, formerly known as Musical.ly.

Parent Governor – we have a vacancy for a parent governor. The role of governor requires a commitment to attend 3 main meetings a year and a couple of sub-committee meetings. Governors will also be required to meet with relevant staff in school. If you think you are able to make this commitment, then please contact school. Should we have more than one willing volunteer then an election will take place. Some people will be ineligible to become a school governor. Please see the attached information.

<u>School Dinner Money</u> – Please would you bring any outstanding payments up-to-date; reminders have been sent out this week. Please ensure that money is placed in an envelope clearly marked with the pupils' name and class. Dinner money is collected every **MONDAY**. We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

<u>Nursery Fund</u> – Snack fund is £2.50 per week.
