School has invited parents and their children into school to share in the experience of having a school meal in the dinner hall. The adult meal cost is £2.00. Any outstanding payments please send the exact money into nursery by Wednesday 10th July in an envelope, clearly marked 'Taster Day' along with your child's name. We can only invite one parent into school as there is limitation on numbers in the dining hall.

We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

From September 2019 any pupils moving up to year 3 will not be entitled to the Universal free school meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. Please see above with ways regarding making payment. If you wish your child to change to a packed lunch, please would you let the office know by the 12th July.

Year 6 dinner money - please check with school office before making any payments in advance as any overpayments at the end of the academic year cannot be refunded.
