Dear Parents

<u>New Reception class</u> –places have been allocated and welcome letters were sent out. The deadline for accepting/ declining a school place is Friday 27th April 2018. Please can all slips to be returned to the school office by this date.

<u>Dinner Money/Nursery snack fund</u> – Please would you bring any outstanding payments up-to-date. Please ensure that money is placed in an envelope clearly marked with the pupils name and class and handed to their class teacher, alternatively you can pay through the Tameside website <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u> school & education > school meals. We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

From September 2018 any pupils moving up to year 3 will not be entitled to the Universal free school meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. Please see above with ways regarding making payment. If you wish your child to change to a packed lunch please would you let the office know by the 13th July.

<u>Year 6 dinner money</u> - please check with school office before making any payments in advance as any overpayments at the end of the academic year cannot be refunded.

School fund for the term will be £6.00 per family for the term payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School. <u>Nursery snack fund</u> - for the term will be £21.00 payable to St Peter's Catholic Primary School; alternatively you can use the School Money on-line system <u>www.schoolmoney.co.uk</u>

<u>Residential trips</u> – please would you bring your payments up-to-date. If you wish to pay by cheque, please make cheques payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School alternatively you can pay using the online payment scheme <u>www.schoolmoney.co.uk</u> The instalment is now overdue for Robinwood £36.00. <u>First Holy Communion</u> –The last parents' meeting is 30th April at 6:00pm in school. Communion ties and sashes will be distributed on the night. Would you please ensure that you have paid for the ties/sashes if you already haven't done so.
