I would like to wish everyone a Happy New Year and on behalf of all the staff thank parents and children for their kind gifts and cards . Infant and Junior Productions - thank you for your kind donations at the door. Total money collected £498.00. <u>Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal</u> – thank you to parents and children the total amount raised was £197.78.

<u>Whole school Mass</u> – Friday 5th January to celebrate the feast of the Epiphany at 9:15am in church, parents and grandparents welcome.

<u>Mass and Assembly</u> – a copy of the mass and assembly rota will be sent out as soon as it is finalised. The first class assembly will be **Year Reception on Friday 2nd February** at 2:45pm. The next class assembly will be **Year 2 on Friday 16**th **February.**

DVD orders - late orders are still being taken for the Christmas DVD. Cost £6.50 each; please send this into school in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, class and details of amount enclosed by Monday 8th January.

Admission to school September 2018 – letters have been posted out. If your child is registered at our school and you haven't received a copy of the application process then contact the school office. Closing date for online applications is Monday 15th January 2018. Please note that school requires a copy of birth and baptism certificates, along with two proofs of residency. Please ensure that all copies have been sent into school before the 15th January. More detailed information is available on the school website under the Admissions section.

<u>Nursery Admissions</u> – we still have nursery places available. We are currently offering 15 hours a week morning session only. Please enquire at the school office about registering for a place.

<u>Residential trips</u> – please would you bring your payments up-to-date. If you wish to pay by cheque, please make cheques payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School alternatively you can pay using the online payment scheme <u>www.schoolmoney.co.uk</u> The next instalments will be due on 19th January 2018 for Kingswood £26.00 and 22nd January for Robinwood £36.00.

<u>School Dinner Money</u> –school dinner money for next term will be £69.76 (32 days), and alternatively you can pay weekly £10.90. School fund next term will be £7.00 per family for the term payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School.

<u>Nursery snack fund</u> for the term will be £24.50 payable to St Peter's Catholic Primary School; alternatively you can use the School Money on-line system <u>www.schoolmoney.co.uk</u>

<u>Swimming Lessons</u> –Year 4 will swim next term. This starts on Monday 8th January. The children will need swimming trunks – **not** sports shorts, a swimsuit – **not** a bikini, a towel in a plastic bag or swimming bag. If children have been prescribed an inhaler, they must take their inhaler with them. Copley will not allow children to wear goggles unless it is for medical reasons, which needs to be in writing.
