Stalybridge Old Band will lead the parade. At the conclusion the parade will return to Armentieres Square. Light refreshments will be served in the Civic Hall.

<u>School Dinner Money</u> –School dinner money for this term will be £80.50 (35 meals). Alternatively, you can pay weekly £11.50 payable to School or via the Tameside MBC website <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u>

We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.
