Dear Parents

Welcome back to our very busy half term leading up to Christmas, with much to do and look forward to.

<u>Remembrance</u> - school will have a minutes' silence at 11.00am tomorrow, Friday 9th November in respect and remembrance. <u>**Remembrance Sunday 11th November**</u> - would any parent and pupils like to volunteer to present a wreath on behalf of the school at the Remembrance service, if so please contact the school office. The wreath will need to be collected from the office tomorrow. The parade leaves Armentieres Square at 10:30am

<u>Class Masses</u> – Year R class Mass will be on Tuesday 13th November 9:00am. Year 3 class assembly is on Friday 9th November, Parents and Grandparents welcome from 2:45pm.

<u>Poetry and Poppies Workshop</u> – Year R – 6 will be having a workshop about life during the first world war on Monday 12th November. School will be funding this event.

<u>Young Shakespeare – Friday 16th November Year 4, 5 & 6</u> – this excellent theatre company will be performing Twelfth Night. The cost per child is £3.00; school also contributes to the cost of this workshop. <u>Admission to school September 2019</u>– letters have been posted out. If your child is registered at our school and you haven't received a copy of the application process, then contact the school office. Closing date for online applications is **15th January 2019.** Please note that school requires a copy of birth and baptism certificates, along with two proofs of residency. School fund next term will be £7.00 per family for the term payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School. <u>Year 5 Residential Trip</u> – please bring your instalments up-to-date. Payment by cash and cheque are acceptable. Payment can be made using the online payment systems <u>www.schoolmoney.co.uk</u> The last instalment of £40.00 was due 19th October.

<u>Parent Governor</u> – we have had 3 nominations for Parent Governor and parents will now be asked to vote. Ballot papers have been sent out today one per family to the eldest child. Please would any votes be return to school by Thursday 15th November.

Operation Christmas Child (shoebox collection) – Due to the high cost of making a shoebox we have decided to ask each class to make 3 shoeboxes between them. This will need organising to avoid having 30 of the same gift. We would like each child to donate 50p to cover the cost of transport and then each child will receive a slip of paper with an item to provide. We have sent out slips with children today. Please could the 50p donation and the items be returned to school for Monday 12th November.

Free on-line parenting course - Tameside Council have invested in 3 award winning, quality marked, online courses by the Solihull Approach (a national NHS organisation for parenting approaches). These courses are for ALL parents-to-be, parents, grandparents or carers of any child from the antenatal period to age 18 years. This course is relevant to parents of all children, including those with special needs, autism, ADHD etc.

We would encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity. These courses are normally £19-£39 per person but are **FREE** with the access codes below to all residents of Tameside.

Once you have accessed the courses using this code you will have non-expiring access even after the code expires.

You will also be asked to verify that you are legitimately entitled to use the access code by entering your postcode. Personal information supplied by you remains private. Your responses to the monitoring questions are anonymised. You will not receive any marketing emails. You will receive congratulatory emails when you complete a module. The Solihull Approach may very occasionally email you to tell you about updates to the course.
