Dear Parents,

A warm welcome back following the Christmas holidays. I hope you all had a wonderful time with your children.

Inset day – the third and final INSET day of the year has now been arranged. School will be closed on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2020 for staff training.

Mass and Assembly - a copy of the mass and assembly rota will be sent out as soon as it is finalised. I'm just waiting on confirmation of one more date for a class mass. The first class mass will be Year 4 on Tuesday 21st January in the school hall. The first class assembly will be Reception on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February.

Admission to school September 2020- letters have been posted. If your child is registered at our school and you haven't received a copy of the application process, then contact the school office. Closing date for online applications is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020. Please note that school requires a copy of birth and baptism certificates, along with two proofs of residency. More detailed information is available on the school website under the Admissions section.

Nursery hours funded – If your child's hours of funding are to increase or decrease from January then please contact the school office or send an email to admin@st-peters.tameside.sch.uk to advise the change in hours. An Addendum form is to be completed.

Dinner Monies / Nursery Snack Fund – school dinner money for next term will be £66.70 (29 days), and alternatively you can pay weekly £11.50 or on-line using the link at www.tameside.gov.uk and click on the link school meals. Nursery snack fund for the term will be £21.00 payable to St Peter's Catholic Primary School; alternatively, you can use the School Money on-line system www.eduspot.co.uk

Year 5 Residential Trip – please bring your instalments up-to-date. Payment by cash and cheque are acceptable. Payment can be made using the online payment systems www.eduspot.co.uk The next instalment will be due 24<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

School swimming - Year 3 will continue to go swimming until the end of this term. Please note the class may return a few minutes late due to possible traffic issues. If the class arrive back after the bell has gone please understand that we are still responsible for dismissing the children from the class so as to avoid any mix- up and safeguard all children. Thank you for your support and understanding with this.

DVD orders - late orders are still being taken for the Christmas DVD. Cost £6.50 each; please send this into school in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, class and details of amount enclosed by Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January.
