All parents and grandparents are welcome to come along and join this lovely mass.

<u>Year 6 SATs</u> – Year 6 will be taking their tests next week. We wish them the very best of luck and remember them in our prayers. It is very important that children are in school on time having had a good sleep and breakfast ready to show what they have learned.

<u>Mini Vinnies</u> – the children have chosen to collect pet food for a local food bank to support families who are struggling to manage. If you would like to support this then please send in any donations of dog & cat food. Thank you!

<u>Dinner Money/Nursery snack fund</u> — Please would you bring any outstanding payments up-to-date. Please ensure that money is placed in an envelope clearly marked with the pupil's name and class and handed to their class teacher, alternatively you can pay through the Tameside website <a href="www.tameside.gov.uk">www.tameside.gov.uk</a> school & education > school meals. We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

From September 2019 any pupils moving up to year 3 will not be entitled to the Universal free school meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. Please see above with ways regarding making payment. If you wish your child to change to a packed lunch, please would you let the office know by the 12<sup>th</sup> July.

<u>Year 6 dinner money</u> - please check with school office before making any payments in advance as any overpayments at the end of the academic year cannot be refunded.

School fund for the term will be £5.00 per family for the term payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School.
