Learn by heart what Jesus teaches us:

- 1. When someone persecutes you, what should you do? **Pray for them** (Matt 5:44)
- 2. When you have enemies, what should you do? Love your enemies (Matt 5:44)
- 3. What does Jesus say when we help the poor, hungry, stranger, naked etc.

Whatever we do to other people, we do to him, "For I was hungry and you fed me, thirsty and you gave me a drink; I was a stranger and you received me in your homes, naked and you clothed me; I was sick and you took care of me ... (Matt 23:34-37)

- 4. What does Jesus say about forgiving others?
 Jesus tell us to forgive seventy times seven 70x7 (Matt 18:21)
- 5. What is the New Commandment that Jesus has given to us? "Love God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength and with all your mind, and your neighbour as yourself" (Luke 10:27)

6. When did Jesus make a **New Covenant** with us?

Jesus made a new covenant with us at the Last Supper when he said: "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood" (Luke 22:20)

7. What does the New Covenant mean for us?

It is a very big promise that Jesus will always be with us. He promises us everlasting happiness and life with him in heaven.

Learn by heart what St John and St Paul teach us:

8. What does St John tell us about love?

"Our love is not to be just words or mere talk, but something real and active" (1 John 3:18)

9. What does St Paul tell us about love?

"Love is always patient and kind; it is never jealous; love is never boastful or conceited; it is never rude or selfish; it does not take offence, and is not resentful" (1Corinthians 13:4-5)

10. What does St Paul say when we fall-out with our friends?

"Bear with one another; forgive each other as soon as a quarrel begins. The Lord has forgiven you; now you must do the same" (Colossians 3: 12-13)
