Year 2 Parent Workshop

On 11th November, Mrs Russell will place a video on the school website for parents of children in Year 2. This video will share details of how parents can help support their child at home with their reading, writing and maths as they approach their special 'quizzes' at the end of Year 2.

Parents' Evenings This will take place on 17th, 18th and 19th November. Parents will receive an e-mail invitation to a Microsoft Teams appointment with your child's class teacher. The invitation will state the date and time of your appointment. If the time is unsuitable, please e-mail the teacher using the class Email address. Your child's class teacher will then get in touch with you to re-arrange an appointment, but this will not be until after Christmas. We are offering appointments on Microsoft Teams so that parents have the opportunity to hold a face to face conversation with the teacher. However, if you would prefer a telephone appointment, please Email the teacher. A telephone appointment will then be arranged for the same allocated time. *In order to fit in an appointment for all parents, please understand that teachers must stick steadfastly to a duration of 5 minutes for each appointment.*

First Holy Communion

The current Year 3 children will celebrate their First Forgiveness on Wednesday, 22nd September 2021, and their First Holy Communion on Saturday, 9th October 2021.

Year 6 transfer from Primary to Year 7 (High School) – September 2020 The online admission process is now open. Parents will need to log on to Tameside MBC school admissions and register to submit an application and access the 'Moving On' booklet www.tameside.gov.uk/admissions. The closing date is **Saturday 31st October 2020**. Admissions submitted after this date will be treated as late and if your application is not submitted on time you are less likely to receive the school of your choice

Moving On / Starting Out - A message from Tameside Admissions for Year 6 and Nursery/Reception parents

We have been notified that Microsoft has blocked the Tameside MBC domain from their system.

This means that parents using Hotmail/live/outlook email addresses will encounter problems with the Tameside online applications system. This means that you will not receive the confirmation email when you register or submit your applications for new reception and new year 7 and this error will prevent you from completing the application.

Parents using these email providers are asked to set up an alternative account using another provider (Gmail for example).

We have taken steps to address this problem with Microsoft, but it is at present unclear if / when this will be resolved.

Nursery Snack Fund Fund amounts will vary due to the staggered intake. Snack fund is £2.50 per week. We also ask for £1.00 a week as a voluntary contribution for curriculum enhancement as explained in the Nursery Prospectus and is available to view on the website under the Admissions section. Please make cheques payable to: St. Peter's Catholic Primary School alternatively payments can be made via School Money Scheme. Next term's snack fund will be £24.50. Thank you to parents who have already sent in their snack fund for this term.

Nursery Wraparound Provision From 3rd September we are pleased to offer wraparound care in our nursery unit. The sessions are from 11:55 am until 15:15. The charge is £10.00 per afternoon session.

30-hour funding Please would you contact the school office if your circumstances change, as this may affect your eligibility. This needs to be in writing within 5 working days. Please contact the school office for more information.

School Dinner Money –School dinner money for next term will be £81.20 (35 meals). Alternatively, you can pay weekly £11.60 payable to School or via the Tameside MBC website www.tameside.gov.uk

We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

If your circumstances change you may be eligible to apply for free school meals. More information is available on the school website under school meals where there is a link to a website www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/sims-tameside where you can complete an online application to see if you are eligible. If it is undecided, then proof of benefits will be required to be shown at school.

School meal enquiries School has introduced an e-mail address schoolmeals@st-peters.tameside.sch.uk where you can contact school regarding any aspect of school meals i.e. payments or changes to packed lunch or school meals.

School fund for next term will be £7.00 per family for the term payable to St. Peter's Catholic Primary School.

Nursery snack fund for the term will be £24.50 payable to St Peter's Catholic Primary School; alternatively you can use the School Money on-line system www.eduspot.co.uk a text will be sent week commencing 2nd November.
