Dear Parents

I hope that you are all keeping well. It is heartening to see so many families engaging with the home learning on Tapestry. Please let your children know that they are always in our thoughts and prayers, even if they are not in school with us right now. Our school building remains open. Please give us a telephone call or send an e-mail to <u>admin@st-peters.tameside.sch.uk</u>, if you feel that there is any support at all that we can offer.

<u>Remote Learning</u> - We recognise that everybody's family situation is different. We also recognise the many challenges faced by families during this time of lockdown – there may be lots of children in the same household, all needing to access a device, children needing help with home learning, parents and carers trying to work from home whilst home-schooling and managing childcare. If you have any worries or concerns AT ALL about home learning, please do not keep these to yourself, but share these concerns with your child's class teacher via Tapestry, in the first instance. Please use the 'comment' or 'reply' function on Tapestry to stay in contact with your child's class teacher. The attachment to this e-mail gives a step-by-step guide to Tapestry. We thank you for all the work you are uploading to Tapestry.

If you experience any technical difficulties when logging in to Tapestry, please telephone school – we will do all we can to help.

Thank you to all children who have uploaded their work to Tapestry. If this is done before 9:30am the day after the work is set, then the work can be marked by the class teacher. Your child will then be able to receive some feedback. Lots of children are uploading work every single day, which is what we are aiming for.

Please encourage your children to watch the videos uploaded by teachers. These contain explanation and demonstration of key facts and enable your children to complete the associated tasks as well as they can.

Children have their log-in details for Times Tables Rock Stars, Numbots and Oxford Owl (for reading). Year 1 and 2 could also access 'Teach Your Monster to Read.'

Nursery – St Peter's Nursery continues to be open to ALL children. This is in line with national government guidance.

<u>Fruit</u> - deliveries of fruit for the Infant children to eat at breaktime have been suspended. Therefore, if your child would like a snack of fresh fruit at morning playtime, we need to ask you to send this in from home – thank you.

<u>School Dinner Money</u> –school dinner money for this term will be £69.60(30 meals). Alternatively, you can pay weekly £11.60 payable to School or via the Tameside MBC website <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u>

We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

If your circumstances change you may be eligible to apply for free school meals. More information is available on the school website under school meals where there is a link to a website <u>www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/sims-tameside</u> where you can complete an online application to see if you are eligible. If it is undecided, then proof of benefits will be required to be shown at school.

<u>Supermarket Vouchers</u> – From next week, families whose children receive Free School Meals will receive an electronic supermarket voucher for £15 per week. These are exactly the same as the vouchers issued during the first lockdown. St. Peter's School will therefore cease to issue food parcels from now on. We ask families to await their supermarket voucher, which will arrive by e-mail next week. We will send a text to let you know to expect them. Please note that if your child is in school, they will continue to receive their Free School Meal from the kitchen at lunchtime, and a voucher will not be issued.

Assessments

Would parents please note that the government has cancelled primary school assessments in 2021. This means that all of the following assessments are cancelled:

Standard Attainment Tests in Year 2 and Year 6

Year 1 phonics screening check

Year 4 multiplication tables check
