What shall we build, you

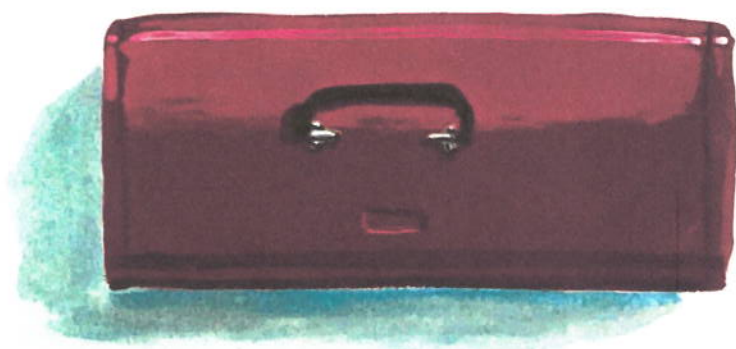

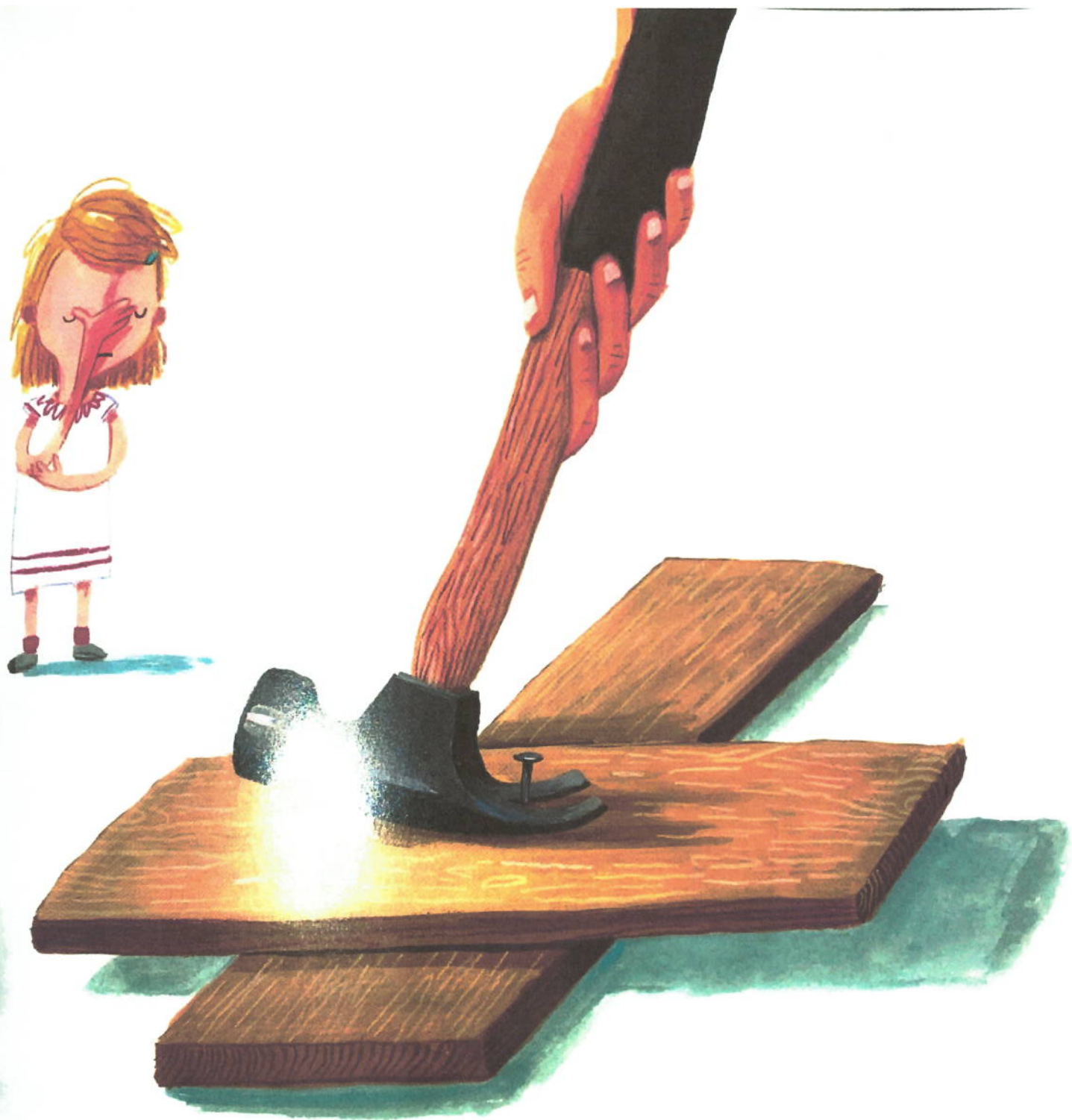
Let's gather all our tools for a start.



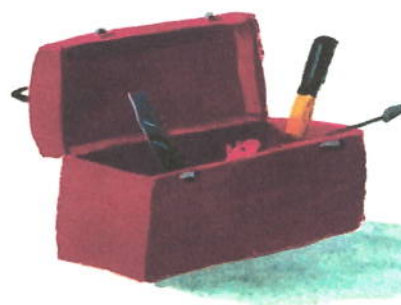
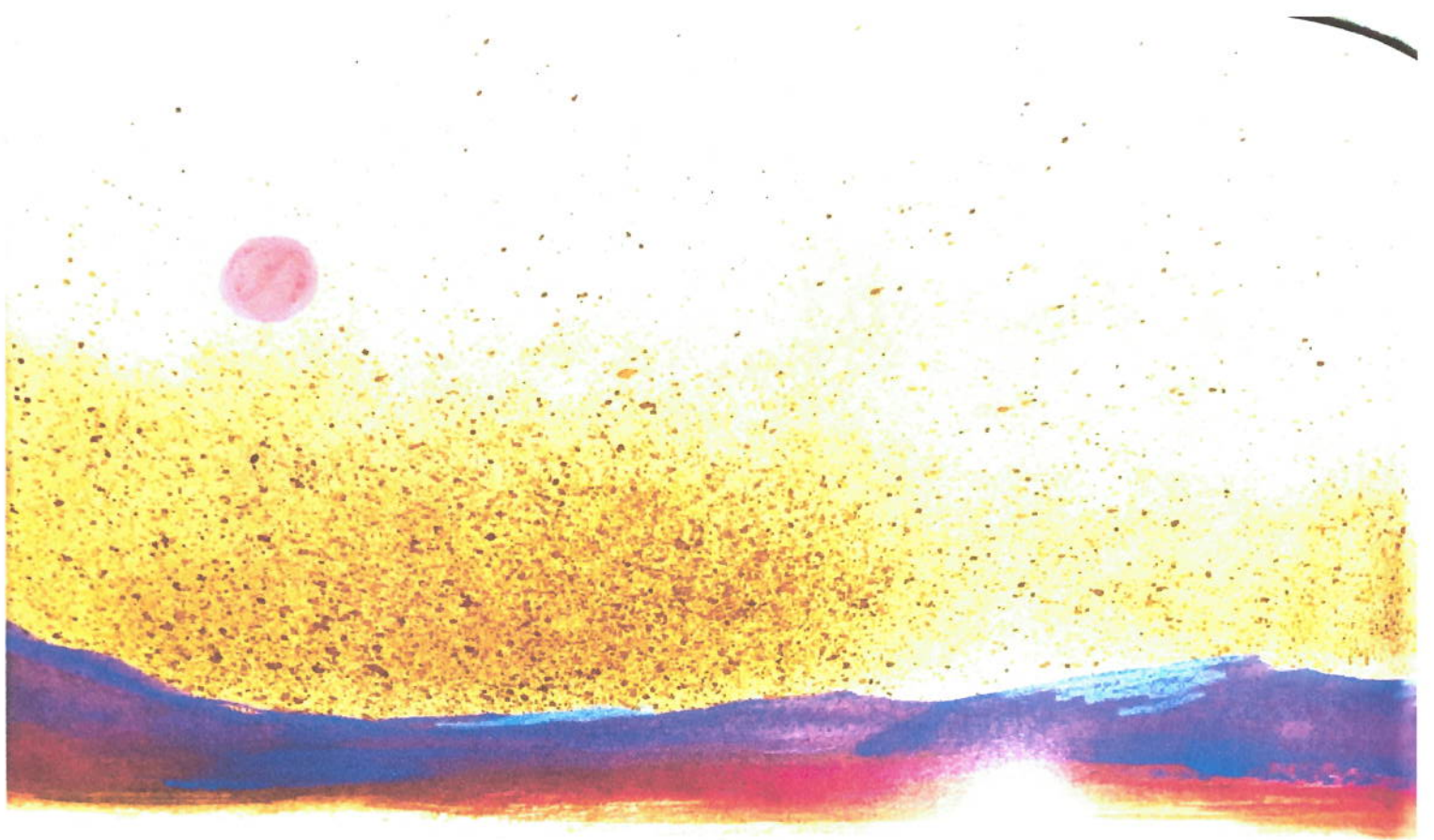




For putting together

where there was none.

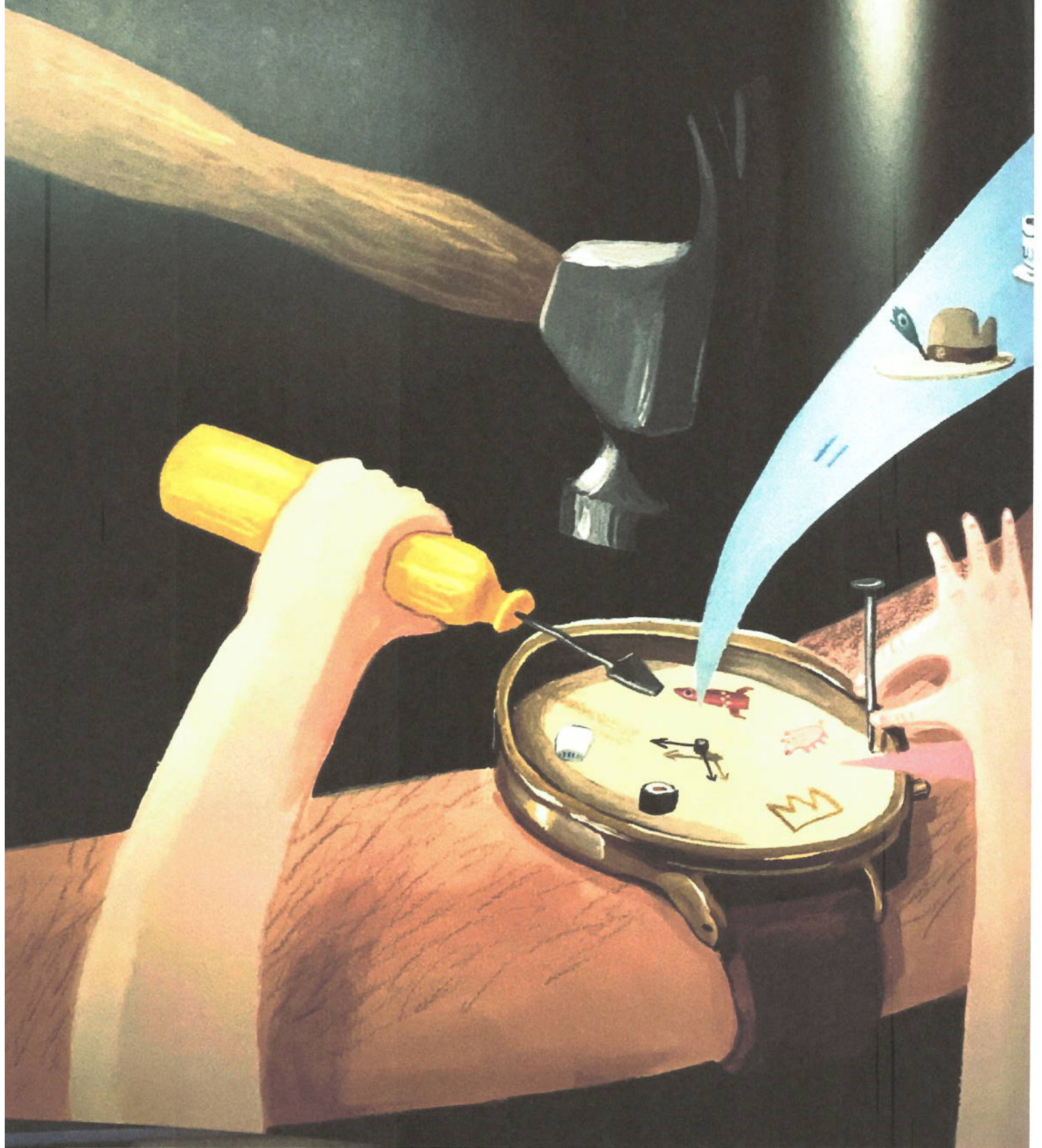


We'll build a house

We'll build a watch to keep our time.

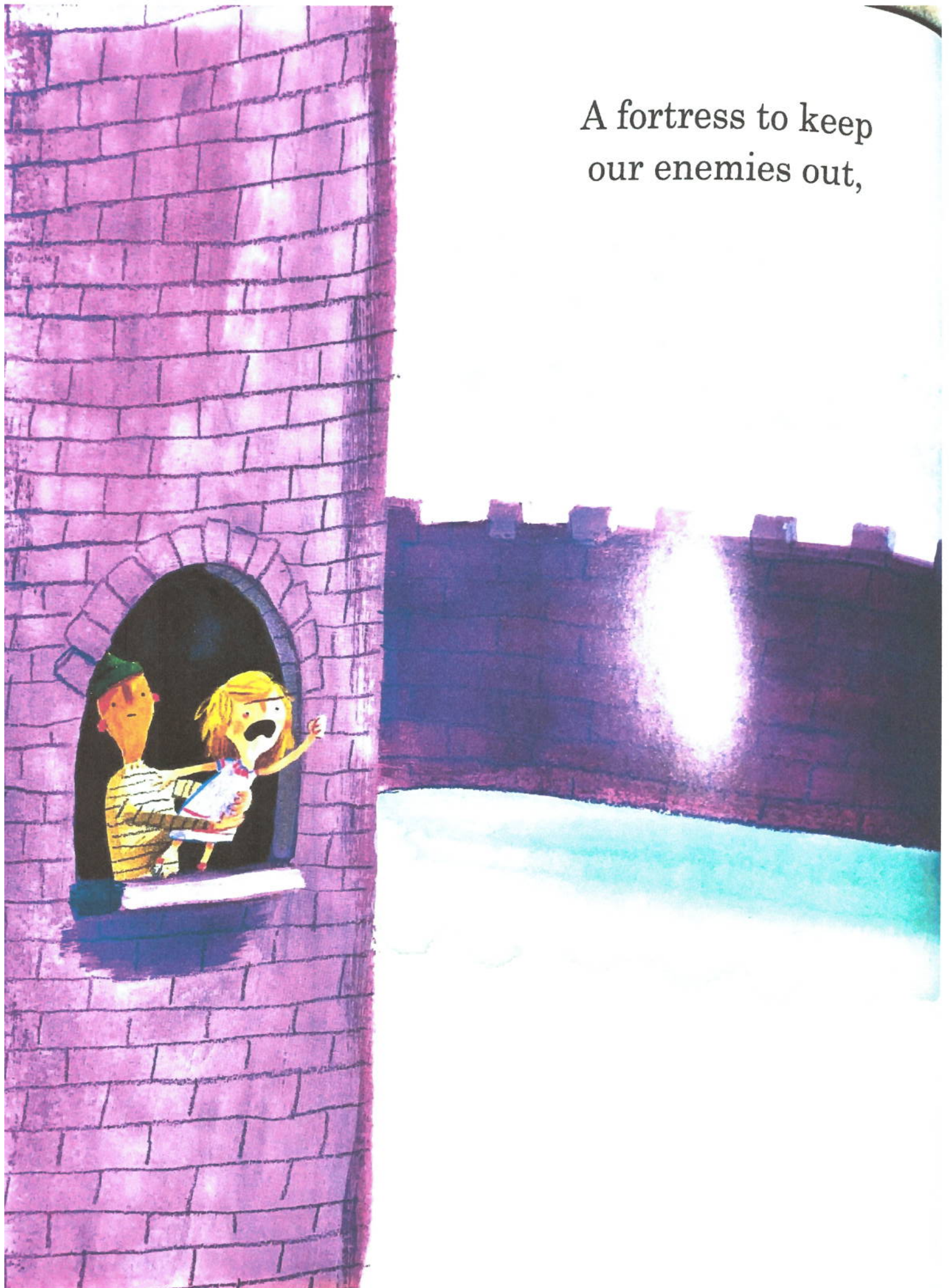


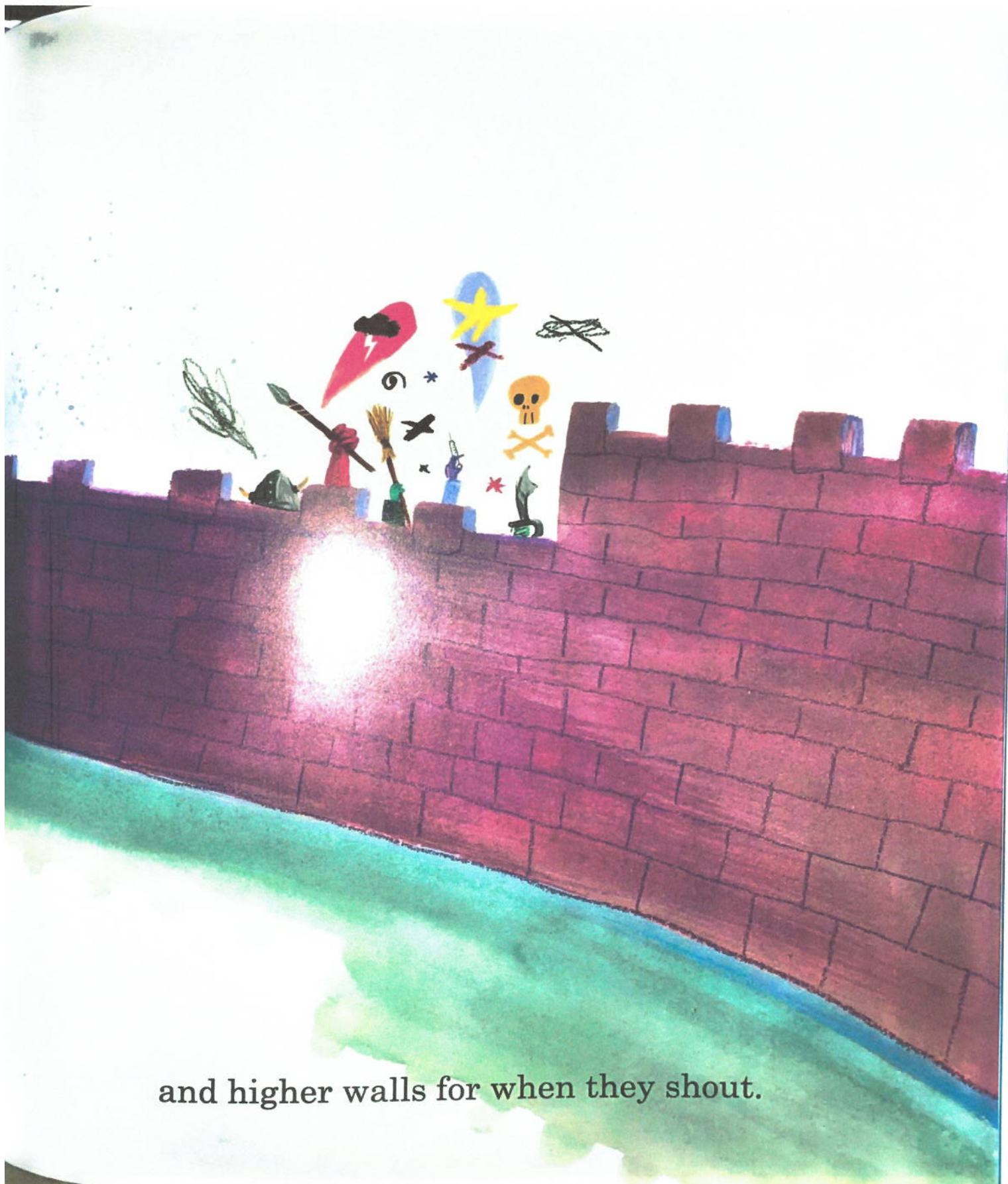
We'll build some love to set aside,



and build a hole where we can hide.

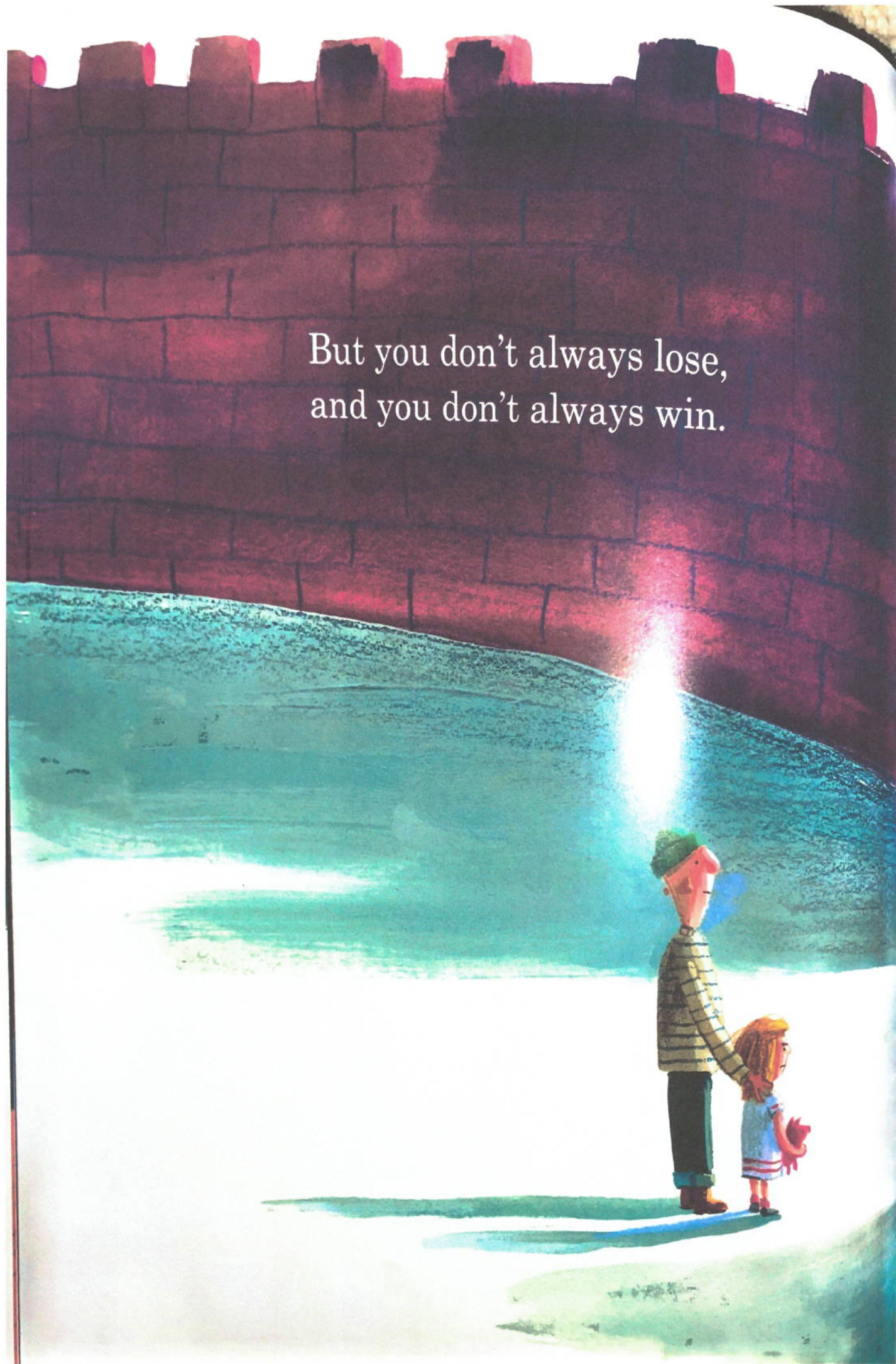
A fortress to keep
our enemies out,

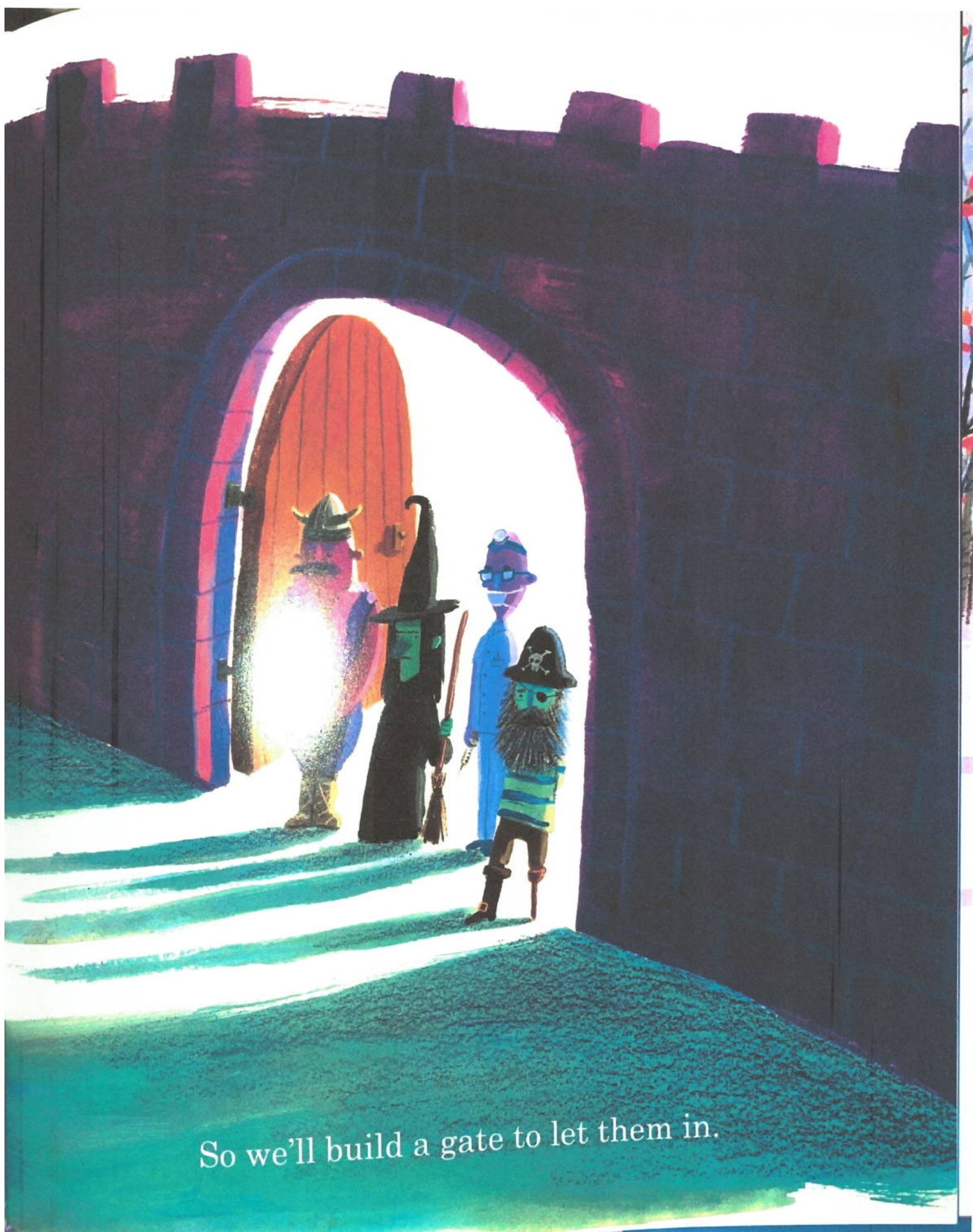




and higher walls for when they shout.

and you don't always win.






So we'll build a gate to let them in.


We'll build a table to drink our tea,
