To write extracts from diaries 	<p>The Victorians – The Victorians lived during the reign of Queen Victoria (1837 to 1901). This was known as the Victorian era.</p> <p>Queen Victoria –She was queen from 1837 until 1901. Prince Albert- Prince Albert was the husband of Queen Victoria. They were married for 21 years until his death in 1861.</p> <p>The Industrial Revolution – A period of change in the way products were made. Key learning questions	<p>Transport - ways of travelling around, including roads, railways, undergrounds, and ships. Railways expanded hugely under the Victorians.</p> <p>The workhouse – A building where very poor people in Britain used to work in exchange for food and shelter.</p> <p>Ragged Schools – Schools set up for poor children.</p> <p>Slates – Used for writing with a slate pencil in schools during the Victorian era instead of pencil and paper.</p> <p>Abacus – A wooden frame with beads on.
