Dear Parents

School will close for the summer break on Friday, 23rd July at 2:00pm.

I have had many discussions with colleagues in school in the past few weeks, and all of us are looking forward immensely to welcoming all of our children back to St. Peter's for the new school year.

School will revert to a universal start time of 8:50am in September, and all classes in the main school will finish together at 3:20pm. The double playground gates on Hough Hill Road, and the single gate on Castle Hall Close will be opened from 8:40am. The Nursery gate will not be opened until 8:55am, when a member of Nursery staff will open this to admit the Nursery children.

Junior children may be left on the junior playground from 8:40am. There will be two members of staff on the junior playground.

Year 1 and Year 2 children may be left on the Infant playground from 8:40am, where there will also be two members of staff. Reception class children should line up with an adult on the path in front of the school office. The perimeter gate will be open, and

there will be staff from Reception available to guide parents to the path in non-the first few days of school in September.

Nursery will continue to be slightly different; their hours will be 8:55am-3:15pm.

However, as we have all experienced, we are in an ever-changing situation in terms of the pandemic. Please keep a close eye on the inbox of your e-mail, as it may be necessary for us to communicate with you by e-mail over the summer break, should local or national government guidance change. If we are guided to revert back to a staggered start and finish time, school will communicate this to you via e-mail over the summer holidays. Please do ensure that the school office hold an up-to-date e-mail, so that we can communicate with you if this is necessary.

<u>New Nursery and Reception starters September 2021</u> - letters have been sent out confirming the September start date. Throughout the summer holidays please would you check your e-mails, as due to the pandemic situation we may need to contact you to change dates, if Government advice guides us to do so.

Leavers' Mass – this will take place on Friday, 23rd July at 9:15am. Due to restrictions in church, just two people are able to attend for each child. Church stewards will be on hand to direct people to seats in church.

<u>Infant Fruit – September</u> – please could we ask that Infant children bring fresh or dried fruit for their morning snack for the first few days of term in September. We are expecting the fruit delivery sometime during the week beginning 06-09-21. We will let parents know as soon as we receive our school fruit!

<u>Free School Meals</u> – if your child is entitled to Free School Meals, then they are also entitled to attend a holiday club during the summer holidays. Please contact school, who can make the necessary referral and enquire about availability for your child.

<u>Mrs Warran</u> – Our Year 3 teacher, Mrs Warran, will be leaving St. Peter's at the end of this term. We wish her well as she moves on to pastures new.

Coronavirus - If you receive a positive test for your child in the evening, over a weekend or during a school holiday, please e-mail: covid@st-peters.tameside.sch.uk to let us know as soon as possible.

From Monday, 26th July onwards, this will no longer be necessary.

This enables us to take any necessary action following a positive test as soon as possible (especially if this involves the closure of a bubble in school). If you or your child have symptoms, you MUST book a PCR test online, or by calling 111. The lateral flow tests, which can be collected from pharmacies/ testing sites and carried out at home, are NOT sufficient. A PCR test is necessary should you have a cough, temperature or loss of taste or smell. This applies even if you have carried out a lateral flow test, and it is negative. Just to emphasise – any positive tests received from 25-07-21 onwards do not need to be reported to school. This is because a positive

<u>Nursery Wraparound Provision</u> - from September we are pleased to offer wraparound care in our nursery unit. The sessions are from 11:55 am until 15:15. The charge is £10.00 per afternoon session.

<u>Nursery Snack Fund/School Fund</u> - Nursery snack fund for next term is £23.80 payable to St Peter's Catholic Primary School alternatively, you can use the School Money on-line system <u>www.eduspot.co.uk</u> Snack fund is £2.50 per week. We also ask for £1.00 a week as a voluntary contribution for curriculum enhancement as explained in the Nursery Prospectus and is available to view on the website under the Admissions section.

<u>School Dinner Money</u> – just a reminder that the price of a school meal has increased to **£2.40** from the 1st September. The amount due for KS2 (juniors) for the autumn term will be 37 days, totalling £88.80. Please ensure that money is placed in an envelope clearly marked with the pupil's name and class and handed to their class teacher, alternatively you can pay through the Tameside website www.tameside.gov.uk school & education > school meals.

We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

If your circumstances change you may be eligible to apply for free school meals. More information is available on the school website under school meals where there is a link to a website <u>www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/sims-tameside</u> where you can complete an online application to see if you are eligible. If it is undecided, then proof of benefits will be required to be shown at school.

From September 2021 any pupils moving up to year 3 will <u>not be</u> entitled to the Universal Free School Meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. Please see above with ways regarding making payment.

<u>**Current Year 2**</u> – from September your child will require a school tie to go with the junior uniform. Ties are available from the school office priced ± 3.00 each or can be purchased online from our suppliers.
