Dear Parents

<u>Class Masses</u> –All family members are welcome to attend. <u>Mass will be celebrated by our Year 2 class on Tuesday 5th July</u> <u>in Church at 9:00 am.</u>

<u>Friday Thanksgiving Assemblies</u> – Parents are welcome to attend these assemblies in school, which all begin at 2:45pm on Fridays. The following classes have a Friday assembly this term:

Year 6 will celebrate their leavers' assembly on Friday, 15th July at 9.15am. The current Year 5 class will have a Friday assembly early in the Autumn term.

<u>School Disco</u> – Thursday 30th June. Nursery and Infants: 5:00-6:00pm, Juniors: 6:15-7:15pm All St. Peter's children welcome. We are so pleased to be able to offer school discos to the children again.

Infants: entrance through the main office doors, exit via the peace garden. (Staff will be on hand to direct)

Juniors: entrance and exit via the main office doors.

<u>Missing PE Kit</u> – Pupils need to always have their PE kit in school as they require it for Dance/Gymnastics and PE on a Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. It has been noted that a number of children do not have their full PE kit in School. Would you please check with your child as to whether they have their full kit in school, as school only have a few items of spare kit.

Thursday 30th June: Sports day – parents welcome to spectate on the school field. PLEASE ENSURE YOUR CHILD HAS THEIR FULL PE KIT IN SCHOOL ON THIS DAY. THEY WILL ALSO NEED TRAINERS.

Year 1: 9.00am Nursery, Reception and Year 2: 10:15am Years 3, 4, 5, and 6: 1.15pm We respectfully request that families do not take photographs whilst on the school field for sports day. We have children in school who cannot be photographed. In the interests of safeguarding and protecting our children, it is very easy to inadvertently catch a child in the background of a photograph, and this child's image is then stored on another person's device. Please support us in this.

We also politely request that parents position themselves on the chairs around the perimeter of the field to watch the events, rather than approaching their child's class. Please understand that, especially in the case of our younger children, staff will be trying to manage the class whilst families are close by. It can be unsettling for some children if parents approach, as other children will then want their parents with them, too. Thank you for your support with this.

We are hoping for a dry day! The event will need to be cancelled if the weather is wet, as it will not be safe for the children to run on the grass.

Robinwood current year 4 – Residential 26th – 28th April 2023

Letters were sent home on Friday 20th May with trip information for next year's residential trip. The deadline for sending in your permission slip along with the £20.00 non-refundable deposit has now passed. If you still wish for your child to attend, please send in the completed form and deposit by Monday 20th June to ensure the school can secure the future booking.

<u>Year 6 Leavers' Production – Treasure Island</u> – This play will be performed on Wednesday, 6th July at 2.00pm and 6:00pm. All children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 are involved. Children in Years 3, 4 and 5 will perform one dance each and will form the choir, and children in Year 6 will take on acting roles. Nursery and Infant children will watch the dress rehearsal during the school day earlier that week. The performance will be filmed. All children in Years 3-6 will need black pumps and plain black leggings/ jeans/ tracksuit bottoms for the production. These can be sent into school in a named carrier bag from next week.

<u>Robinwood residential current Year 6 July 2022</u> – the trip will take place on Monday 18th until Wednesday 20th July 2022. A text reminder was sent today 23rd June chasing up the outstanding balances. *All outstanding balances are to be paid prior to your child participating in the trip.*

<u>Midday staff</u> – School is looking to recruit a permanent midday assistant. We also welcome applications from people who would like to be casual midday assistants (on an 'as and when' basis). Please see the 'vacancies' tab of our school website for an application pack.

<u>School Meals</u> - school dinner money for this term will be £69.60 (29 meals). Alternatively, you can pay weekly £12.00 payable to School or via the Tameside MBC website <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u> We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

If your circumstances change you may be eligible to apply for free school meals. More information is available on the school website under school meals where there is a link to a website <u>www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/sims-tameside</u> where you can complete an online application to see if you are eligible.

Year 6 dinner money - please check with school office before making any payments in advance as any overpayments at the end of the academic year cannot be refunded.

From September 2022 any pupils moving up to year 3 will not be entitled to the Universal Free School Meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. Please see above with ways regarding making payment. If you wish your child to change to a packed lunch, please would you let the office know no later than Friday 15th July.

<u>Year 3 transition Current Year 2</u> – from September your child will require a school tie to go with the junior uniform. Ties are available from the school office priced at £3.00 each or can be purchased online from our suppliers. The junior uniform list is available to download from the school website <u>www.stpeterstalybridge.co.uk</u>

<u>School Fund</u> – this half term school fund is £6.00. We are always especially grateful for these voluntary contributions, as it enables us to pay for items to enhance our curriculum provision for the children, as well as costumes for plays and productions.

<u>Nursery Snack Fund</u> - snack fund is £2.50 per week. We also ask for £1.00 a week as a voluntary contribution for curriculum enhancement as explained in the Nursery Prospectus and is available to view on the website under the Admissions section. Nursery snack fund for next term is £20.30 cheques to be payable to St Peter's Catholic Primary School; alternatively, you can use the School Money on-line system <u>www.eduspot.co.uk</u> A text has been sent out week commencing 13th June.

<u>First Sacraments</u> – First Forgiveness <u>for the current Year 3 children</u> will take place at 6.00pm in St. Peter's Church on Thursday 22nd September.

First Holy Communion for this group of children will take place on Saturday 8th October 2022 at 10:30am in St. Peter's Church.
