Robinwood current year 4 – Residential 26<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023 - Letters were sent home on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May with trip information for next year's residential trip. The deadline for sending in your permission slip along with the £20.00 non-refundable deposit has now passed. If you still wish for your child to attend, please send in the completed form and deposit no later than **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July** to ensure the school can secure the future booking.

Robinwood residential current Year 6 July 2022 – the trip will take place on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> until Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022. A text reminder was sent 8<sup>th</sup> July chasing up the outstanding balances. *All outstanding balances are to be paid prior to your child participating in the trip.* 

<u>School Dinner Money</u> – please would you bring any outstanding payments up to date. Please ensure that money is placed in an envelope clearly marked with the pupil's name and class and handed to their class teacher, alternatively you can pay through the Tameside website <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u> school & education > school meals.

We will not be able to issue a school dinner to any child where there is a debt of more than £20.00. In such cases parents will be expected to provide their child with a packed lunch.

If your circumstances change you may be eligible to apply for free school meals. Year 6 dinner money - please check with school office before making any payments in advance as any overpayments at the end of the academic year cannot be refunded.

From September 2022 any pupils moving up to year 3 will not be entitled to the Universal Free School Meals therefore any meals taken will have to be paid for. Please see above with ways regarding making payment. If you wish your child to change to a packed lunch, please would you let the office know no later than Friday 15th July.

<u>Year 3 transition Current Year 2</u> – from September your child will require a school tie to go with the junior uniform. Ties are available from the school office priced at £3.00 each or can be purchased online from our suppliers. The junior uniform list is available to download from the school website <u>www.stpeterstalybridge.co.uk</u>

<u>School Fund</u> – this half term school fund is £6.00. We are always especially grateful for these voluntary contributions, as it enables us to pay for items to enhance our curriculum provision for the children, as well as costumes for plays and productions.
