# Messiah

Messiah or the Anointed One is the figure promised by God to the Jews for the salvation of the world. ... The Jews think that the Messiah will be a human being that will save Israel and lead the whole world into the End Of Days and eternal peace.

Key Vocabulary

#### Faith

Strong belief in the doctrines of a religion.

## <u>Holy Week</u>

The week before Easter, starting on Palm Sunday.

#### Palm Sunday

The Sunday before Easter, which the Christ's entry into Jerusalem is celebrated.

## Holy Thursday

Also known as Maundy Thursday, the Christian holy day falling on the Thursday before Easter. It commemorates the Washing of the Feet and Last Supper.

## The Last Supper

The final meal that Jesus shared with His Apostles in Jerusalem before His crucifixion.

## Good Friday

The Friday before Easter Sunday, on which the Crucifixion of Christ is commemorated.

## <u>Crucifixion</u>

An ancient form of execution in which a person is nailed to a cross.

## **Transfiguration**

A complete change of form or appearance into a spiritual state. (Matthew 17:2)
