The Jews think that the Messiah will be a human being that will save Israel and lead the whole world into the End Of Days and eternal peace.</p> <p>Faith Strong belief in the doctrines of a religion.</p> <p>Holy Week The week before Easter, starting on Palm Sunday.</p> <p>Palm Sunday The Sunday before Easter, which the Christ's entry into Jerusalem is celebrated.</p> <p>Holy Thursday Also known as Maundy Thursday, the Christian holy day falling on the Thursday before Easter. It commemorates the Washing of the Feet and Last Supper.</p> <p>The Last Supper The final meal that Jesus shared with His Apostles in Jerusalem before His crucifixion.</p> <p>Good Friday The Friday before Easter Sunday, on which the Crucifixion of Christ is commemorated.</p> <p>Crucifixion An ancient form of execution in which a person is nailed to a cross.</p> <p>Transfiguration A complete change of form or appearance into a spiritual state. (Matthew 17:2)</p>
