The First Sunday of Advent



"Light the Advent candle one, now the waiting has begun."

Dear Parents and Carers,

Tomorrow we will mark the beginning of the holy season of Advent in school, when we wait in joyful hope for Christmas Day – the birth of Jesus. As a school, we will join together in prayer and song, and we welcome all of our families to our Advent mass in church next Wednesday at 9.15am. This Advent we will be collecting gifts for children in Tameside who may not have presents to open on Christmas morning. Mrs Sibson, our RE lead, has sent a memo this week about the Tameside Toy Appeal. It is also attached to this newsletter. Please feel free to support this appeal if you are able to do so. We understand, however, in the cost of living crisis at the moment, that this is not a choice that everyone may feel able to make, so please feel under no pressure at all to donate.

<u>Christmas Productions</u> – *please email your ticket request by tomorrow (1st December)*. Please also ensure that your child has a pair of black PE pumps for their Christmas play and please check that these pumps still fit them! We only have a limited stock of spare pumps in school.

Junior children will need to return to school for 5.30pm on the evening of 13th December; ready for the production to begin at 6.00pm.

We greatly look forward to welcoming you all to share in 'Prickly Hay' and 'Snow White.'

<u>Christmas Lunch</u> - the children are invited to have a Christmas Dinner on Tuesday 19th December. If your child is in Year 3 to Year 6 and normally has a packed lunch and would like to have a school dinner please could a payment of £2.95 be paid via the Tameside website - <u>https://www.tameside.gov.uk/schoolmeals</u> All orders must be received no later than tomorrow - **Friday 1st December 2023**. Children in Reception to Year 2 who normally have a packed lunch can apply to have a Christmas Dinner and payment is not required. Please note – Christmas Dinner is for children in Reception to Year 6.

If your order is placed after this date your child will not be eligible for a Christmas dinner.

Children who normally have a school dinner will automatically be included in this special meal Children are also invited to wear party clothes on this day.

<u>St. Peter's Nursery Unit</u> – we have offered some places to families of Nursery-aged children and they will be beginning with us in our Nursery class from January, 2024. <u>Parents' Evenings</u> – it was lovely to welcome parents and carers into school to discuss the progress and development of each individual child. Our thanks go to all parents who came to meet with their child's class teacher. Here at St. Peter's, we very much value the supportive partnership we have with all of our families.

Thank you also for the wonderful positive feedback on the parental questionnaires. As a senior leadership team in school, we will meet to discuss next steps arising from any constructive feedback that parents and carers have given. If anyone did not receive a questionnaire to complete at parents' evening, and would like one, please obtain one of these from the school office. They can then be returned to your child's class teacher.

<u>School drop-off</u> – we politely ask parents to vacate the playground once they have dropped children at school in the mornings. It is getting a little bit crowded at the top of the steps to the Infant playground! Please understand that the first priority of the staff on duty is to keep the children on the playground safe. Staff need visual access to the gate on Hough Hill Road, and our junior children need access to the steps so that they can walk into school.

<u>Admission to school September 2024</u> – letters have either been posted or handed out directly. If your child is registered at our school and you have not received a copy of the application process, then contact the school office. Closing date for online applications is **15th January 2024.** Please note that school requires a copy of birth and baptism certificates, along with two proofs of residency. **Even if proof of residency was submitted for a Nursery application a further 2 proof of residency is required for the 2024 admission process.** More detailed information is available on the school website under the School Admissions section.

<u>Nasal Flu Vaccination Year Reception to Year 6</u> – the Department of Health have announced that all children in Year R - 6 are going to be offered a flu immunisation every year. At our school, the immunisation will take place on Thursday 7th December.

NHS Guidance on keeping children well this winter - Tameside Public Health have produced the attached leaflet with advice to help keep children well this winter. This includes information about ways to reduce the chance of catching and passing on infections, some of the more common winter illnesses and how to manage them, as well as information on vaccinations. <u>PE Kit</u> - please ensure that you child has their full PE kit in school. Details of the PE uniform can be found under the 'Parent Information' tab on our school website. Please ensure junior children have their full outdoor kit – navy or black sweater and navy or black tracksuit/ jogging bottoms. Thank you very much for your support with this.

<u>First Holy Communion</u> and First Sacraments – First Forgiveness for the Year 3 children will take place at 6:00pm in St. Peter's Church on Thursday, 8th February 2024. Year 4 children will make their First Holy Communion at St. Peter's Church on Saturday, 18th May. There will be a whole school thanksgiving mass to celebrate the journey of our Year 4 children on Wednesday, 22nd May at 9.15am, to which all families in school and parishioners are invited.

Robinwood Residential Year 5 1st – 3rd May 2024 – a chase up text has been sent showing outstanding deposits and payments to date. Please bring all payments up to date as the 5th instalment of £62.00 is due 30th January 2024.

<u>School Fund</u> – the amount for the Academic year is £38.00, payment can be made online via the School Money Scheme. This has been set up so you may choose the amount you would like to pay as this is a voluntary donation. We are most grateful for any contributions you are able to make. All monies donated are spent on wider curriculum opportunities for the children.

<u>Nursery Snack Fund</u> - snack fund is £2.50 per week. We also ask for £1.00 a week as a voluntary contribution for curriculum enhancement. Payments are made via School Money Scheme. Nursery snack fund for this term will be £26.60. A reminder text has been sent out this week.

<u>Nursery Wraparound Provision</u> – we are pleased to offer wraparound care in our nursery unit. The sessions are from 11:55 am until 15:15. The charge is £15.00 per each afternoon session. Please speak with Mrs Walker or Mrs Evans to arrange any additional afternoons.

<u>Eligibility funding for 15 hours extended (pm session)</u> - please ensure that you apply for spring term (4th January until 28th March) as advised by the e-mail / text you will receive from the Government inviting you to reapply. You must reconfirm your eligibility every 3 months. If you apply more than 3 months before the term starts, you will have to reconfirm your eligibility in your account in order to keep your code valid.

<u>School Meals</u> - please note we have been notified by Tameside MBC that the price of school meals is now £2.95 per day. The new weekly total will be £14.75. The total amount for this terms meals will be £112.10 (38 meals)
