<p>To listen and sing to music in a Latin style (Bossa Nova)</p> <p>To find the pulse/beat and understand that it is the heartbeat of the music.</p> <p>To recognise and name two instruments they hear - singers, keyboards, bass, guitar, percussion.</p> <p>To copy back rhythms heard.</p> <p>To understand that pitch is high and low sounds.</p> <p>To identify pitch in a song.</p> <p>To begin to control voices and use pitch</p> <p>To use instruments and play focusing on pitch.</p> <p>To compose own music</p>	<p>Bossa Nova – Brazilian latin music based on the tune rather than percussion.</p> <p>Pulse – the heartbeat of the music</p> <p>Beat – another name for pulse</p> <p>Rhythm – a repeated sequence of beats</p> <p>Pitch – how high or low a sound is.
