<u>Thank you</u> to our Reception families for understanding that it is not always possible for Mrs Kirkpatrick and Mrs Green to chat fully whilst they are receiving children from yourselves between 8.40am and 8.50am

each morning. This is simply because staff are fully occupied with welcoming the children into school at this time and ensuring their supervision. Of course, if you need to speak with staff in Reception, you are more than welcome to come to the school office before 8.40am, or to speak at the end of the school day. If these times are not convenient, please feel free to telephone or Email school in order to arrange an appointment.

<u>Robinwood Residential Year 5 – 30^{th} April – 2^{nd} May</u> – a chase up text has been sent showing outstanding deposits and payments to date. Please can you ensure all payments are brought up to date as the next instalment of £66.00 is due today – 15^{th} November.

Postcards – Please send in any postcards from your days out or holidays in the British Isles – they will be placed on our geography display!

<u>Parking</u> – Please park considerately when parking on the streets surrounding our school as this causes hazards for children and families on their way to and from school.

<u>Asda Rewards</u> - Between 2nd September and 30th November 2024 every time you shop with Asda using your Asda Rewards app, Asda will donate 0.5% of the value of your shop to your chosen primary school. <u>School Fund</u> – the amount for the Academic year is £38.00, payment can be made online via the School Money. This has been set up so you may choose the amount you would like to pay as this is a voluntary donation. We are most grateful for any contributions you are able to make all monies donated are spent on wider curriculum opportunities for the children.

<u>PE Kit</u> - please ensure that you child has their full PE kit in school. Details of the PE uniform can be found on the 'Uniform' page under the 'Parent Information' tab on our school website. Please ensure junior children have their full outdoor kit – navy or black sweater and navy or black tracksuit/ jogging bottoms. This is because of the weather becoming cooler as we go into the season of Autumn. Thank you.

<u>Nursery Snack Fund</u> - snack fund is £2.50 per week. We also ask for £1.00 a week as a voluntary contribution for curriculum enhancement. Payments are made via School Money. Nursery snack fund for this half term is £24.50.

<u>Nursery Wraparound Provision</u> – we are pleased to offer wraparound care in our nursery unit. The sessions are from 11:55 am until 15:15. The charge is £15.00 per each afternoon session. Please speak with Mrs Walker or Miss O'Brien to arrange any additional afternoons.

School Meals - The amount due for KS2 (juniors) for this half term is £112.00 (35 meals). Please note: - you will no longer be able to use the TMBC website to pay for school meals, this is due to the change in catering providers from Monday 18th November. Payments for school meals will be made via School Money - www.edsp.co/sm-login. The amount allocated on school money will depend on if you were in credit with TMBC as this will carry forward to the balance owed up to 20th December. Any arrears via TMBC will be allocated to school money via a different payment, please could you ensure all payments are cleared and up to date. Messages will be sent next week with your child's new dinner money total (if in credit) and arrears balance.

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If your circumstances change you may be eligible to apply for free school meals. More information is available on the school website under school meals where there is a link to a website
