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Year 3 sacramental programme	This weekend we are delighted to share in the sacrament of the Eucharist with our Year 3 children as they make their First Holy Communion. We thank Miss Cooper and Mrs Meola for preparing the children so beautifully, and we join together with our families, and our parish prayer sponsors in this wonderful step on the faith journey of our children. The mass to celebrate the First Holy Communion of our children will take place at 10.30am on Saturday, 17 May in St Peter's Church. We very much appreciate these children giving up part of their weekend in support of our school, and we are grateful to the families for transporting their children to and from school on a Saturday.
