We are delighted to share with you the trips that are booked for Year 6 in the Summer term.

**Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June: Dukinfield Town Hall BBC Philharmonic School Workshop**

We have been given the fantastic opportunity to attend this workshop- there is no cost for the visit. This will be during the school day. We will walk to the venue and walk back after the workshop. You need to indicate on the reply slip for permission for your child to attend.

**Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> June: Big Arts Week visit to Manchester Art Gallery**

We will be walking to Stalybridge train station to catch the train to Manchester Victoria. We will then head up to Manchester Art Gallery for a tour of the galleries. In the afternoon, we will take a look at street art in the Northern Quarter and then head towards Cathedral Gardens to sketch some of Manchester's impressive architecture. We will be back at school for the end of the school day.

**Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> June: Visit to Llandudno, North Wales.**

An early start (6.45am) to travel to Llandudno for a seaside day trip- linked to our geography topic in the Summer term. After we arrive, we will take a walk down the pier before taking the tramway up to the Great Orme. We will then walk to the Copper Mines where we will go underground. We hope to return to school by 6pm- depending on the traffic.

The children will require a packed lunch for all three trips. Children who receive free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch on the day.

The total cost of the trips is £48. We appreciate that this is a substantial amount, and we would encourage anyone who may experience difficulties in paying for the trips to telephone Mrs Ryan in confidence. Payments can be made by two instalments due Friday 13<sup>th</sup> June (£5.00 for the Manchester visit) and Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June (£43 for the Llandudno visit). I would be grateful if you could return the permission slip below for your child before Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> June. I have booked the trips for 25 children but need to notify the venues as soon as possible if the numbers change.

I will provide further details about the trips nearer the time.
