



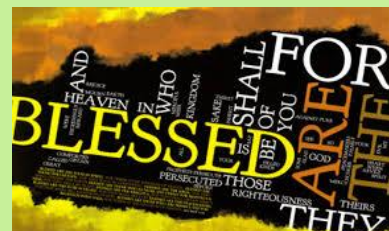

Children walking home from school



We know that a number of our older children walk home from school each day, and that this is an important element of developing our children's independence, once their family have made the decision that this is the right thing for them to do.

We also know that many of these children carry a mobile phone in case they need to contact an adult urgently whilst walking home.

We ask, please, that families in this position just have a quick chat with their children this weekend to ensure that the children are acting as safely as possible. We would be so sad to hear about children having an accident near the roads if the phones they carry are being used for filming and for FaceTiming as they walk, preventing the children from being able to see and hear traffic as well as they ought to, and potentially making the children more vulnerable to people trying to steal their devices.
