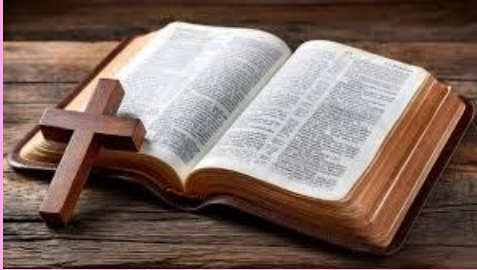

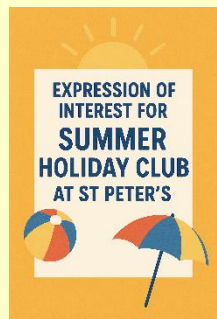

### Mobile Phones and Electronic Devices

We kindly remind our families of the importance of adult supervision whilst children are using devices. We are increasingly aware, from conversations with children, that some children are viewing content online which is upsetting or disturbing to them. They are then feeling worried and upset in school.

Children are also telling us that they are using their devices in bedrooms late into the night. There are many researched reports available which show that late night device use can disrupt sleep, and make it more difficult to switch off and rest. Children are then arriving at school tired and struggling to focus.

We encourage our families to set a **device bedtime** or limit, and to store devices in a shared family space overnight. Establishing these healthy habits supports children's wellbeing, learning and overall development.
