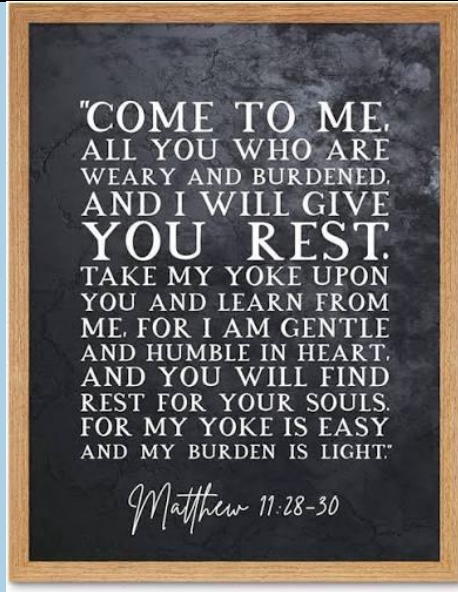

Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 from 9.15am on the school field

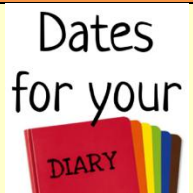
Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 from 1.15pm on the school field. Families are welcome to spectate on the field.

Children will need their own pumps or trainers on this day – we will not have enough spare pumps to give out, as four classes of children will be taking part at the same time.

We must insist that spectators do not photograph or film during sports day, for reasons of child protection and safeguarding.

We also ask that spectators stay in the designated zones on the field. It is vital that staff can view all children at all times, and spectators coming into the participation areas impedes this view. Some of our younger children may also get upset – for example, if their family members are not able to be present, and family members of other children are coming over to speak to their own children.
